2025 Legislation

- <u>SB 386</u> Adds virtual credit cards to the types of payments that can be used with a dental provider.
- SB 412 Requires home care aides to complete a training related to the needs of patients with Alzheimer's and dementia as part of their bi-annual registration renewal.
- SB 507 -Provides tribes with an opportunity to contribute to the Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) of the local government.
- <u>SB 567</u> Establishes a regulatory pathway to transition some idle wells to energy storage in the future.
- <u>SB 642</u> Strengthens the California Equal Pay Act.
- <u>SB 676</u> Expedites the rebuilding of communities recovering from wildfire-declared emergencies.
- SB 702 Boosts transparency for Gubernatorial and Legislative appointments.
- SB 778 Expands access to the Migrant Childcare and Development Program.
- SB 825 Boosts enforcement authority at the Department of Financial Protection and Innovation.
- SB 831 Establishes the Department of Conservation as the primary state agency responsible for the investigation of geologic hazards and acknowledges the exacerbating influence of climate change stressors on geologic hazards.
- SB 840 Cap and Invest Reauthorization
